Clark Memorial Health, part of the Regional Health Network, a Norton Healthcare and LifePoint Health partnership, is a 241-bed acute care facility located on a 22-acre campus, along with two medical office buildings and an outpatient surgery center, in Jeffersonville, Indiana. The hospital offers comprehensive emergent, acute and elective health care services, including cardiology, thoracic and vascular surgery, orthopedic surgery, cancer care, women's health and obstetrics, imaging and interventional radiology. Clark Memorial Health also owns an urgent care and diagnostic imaging center and manages its growing physician offices through the Clark Physician Group, which employs more than 50 providers.
